International Camping Cards

The Camping Card International (CCI) is a useful and widely recognised document throughout Europe at camping and caravanning sites. The CCI is only issued by affiliate members of the Federation International Camping and Caravanning Association (F.I.C.C). The Australian Automobile Association is a F.I.C.C member.

A CCI card is a discount card at more than 3,000 campsites throughout Europe. You can search for these sites [here](#). All campers that hold a CCI must read and abide the Campers Code as stipulated on the back of the application.



Why do I need a CCI?

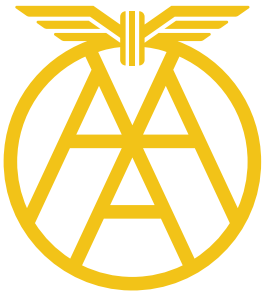
Some European camping sites require that you have an CCI to camp on the site. The CCI is a respected proof of identity that has the same value as a passport for the campsite owner and will be held by the park owner when camping at their site.

When you purchase a CCI you receive insurance for yourself and the other campers with you. The full liability insurance scheme can be read [here](#).

Please ensure you read the Insurance Liability Scheme documentation to ensure it is sufficient to meet the needs of your proposed travel. The Insurance Liability Scheme includes:

- you receive cover under the insurance until the expiry of your camping card.
- the territory limits are worldwide except for the application of the Laws and any costs incurred in respect of any claim arising in United States of America and Canada or any territory where the Laws of United States of America and Canada might apply.
- personal accident insurance up to 10 persons travelling with you. Each person EUR 25,000
Event Limit: EUR 1,800,000
- many exclusions within the policy so please read the exclusions clause.

How do I apply?

- a) Fill out the application form
 - b) Provide copy of the following:
 - Passport (in colour) or Passports where the applicant holds dual passports.
 - current club membership (NRMA, RACV, RACQ, RAA, RAC, RACT, AANT)
Note: You must be a club member to receive a CCI
 - current drivers' licence (in colour)
 - c) Post the form and documents listed in (b) to:

 - d) The AAA will email you an invoice for payment.
 - e) Once the payment is received the AAA will process and post your CCI.
- Please allow at least 10 working days once all the correct information has been provided to the AAA. The CCI will then be posted via Australia Post within Australia.
